Dubrovnik – Split - Zadar – Plitvice – Zagreb (8 Nights/9 Days)

Highlights: visits of Dubrovnik, Split, Blue Cave, Hvar, Zadar, Plitvice National Park, Zagreb
January 2026- December 2026



Itinerary:

DAY 1:

Arrival to Dubrovnik airport.

Private transfer from airport to your hotel. Rest of the day at leisure.

Overnight at the hotel in Dubrovnik area.

DAY 2:

Breakfast at the hotel.

Dubrovnik history & Game of Thrones walking sightseeing tour (duration approx. 3 hrs)

“Those who seek paradise on earth”, George Bernard Shaw once wrote, “should come to Dubrovnik”. The old city of Dubrovnik has remained basically unchanged since the thirteenth century. Its medieval ramparts encircle the city which pedestrians can enter through one of two gates - either way, they find themselves joining the evening promenade Stradun which you can either join or watch, a drink in hand, from one of the various cafes and restaurants along the way. The city is alive with open air markets, artisans’ shops and studios of artists, Baroque churches and Gothic-Renaissance palaces, unexpected courtyards, and covered loggias. Take a walk through the narrow streets of the Old Town and get ready to be amazed with the history still preserved in the locations where the screenshots for Game of Thrones were taken. Our guide will show you the locations on the city walls, while telling you the story of Kings Landing.

Rest of the day at leisure.

Overnight at the hotel in Dubrovnik area.

DAY 6:

Breakfast at the hotel.

Private transfer from Zadar to Plitvice (duration approx. 2 hrs)

Free time for the visit of the Plitvice National Park with entrance fee included

Plitvice National Park is one of the most beautiful and best preserved. National parks in the country. This is why the entire lakes and surrounding area were declared a national park in 1949 and are listed on the UNESCO’s list of World Heritage Sites because of its exceptional beauty. It is a valley situated between high forested mountains in which lie, one below another, a string of sixteen beautiful lakes of crystal blue and green waters. Fed by small streams and brooks, they spill into each other in 92 foaming cascades and thundering waterfalls. The lakes themselves cover about 2 square kilometers and the entire national park covers 200 square kilometers.

Overnight at the hotel in Plitvice area.

DAY 7:

Breakfast at the hotel.

Private transfer from Plitvice to Zagreb (duration approx. 2 hrs)

In the afternoon,

Zagreb walking sightseeing tour with local guide (duration approx. 2 hrs)

Zagreb grew up on two neighbouring hills: Kaptol - the centre of spiritual and religious life of north-western Croatia

DAY 3:

Breakfast at the hotel.

Private transfer from Dubrovnik to Split. (Duration approx. 3,5 hrs)

In the afternoon, **Split sightseeing tour with local guide (duration approx. 2 hrs)** The old town of Split is built on and around the spectacular Roman Palace erected by the Roman Emperor Diocletian (born in Salona – today's Solin) in the 4th century. The walking tour starts with a visit to the cellars of the Palace that are still very well preserved. The cellars offer a good view at how the life in the Palace was organized. Other sights such as the Golden Gate, the Silver Gate, the Peristyle Square etc. will be seen from the outside.
Overnight at the hotel in Split area.

DAY 4:

Breakfast at the hotel.

OPTIONAL: Blue Cave and Hvar excursion from Split (duration approx. 8 hrs) – SIC, available May – October
Witness the originality and magnificence of the Blue Cave on Biševo Island. Float in Stiniva Cove, taking in the towering cliffs that encircle you. Strap on your diving mask and explore a thriving underwater world by Budikovac Island before visiting Palmižana Bay. Sign off your day with a stroll through the quaint streets of Hvar Town, lined with Venetian palaces, a palm-dotted seafront, and bustling squares.

OR

OPTIONAL: Private excursion to Hvar with local guide by public ferry (duration approx. 8 hrs)

Embark the local ferry /catamaran to Hvar.

Upon arrival, **Hvar sightseeing tour (duration approx. 1,5 hr)**

Enjoy a tour of the culture, art and history of Hvar, one of the principal destinations on the Dalmatian Riviera. Hvar is home to fiercely proud, determined and courteous people, who are eager to show off their city. Walk around historical center of Hvar, called Groda; you'll also see the city square, the arsenal, the theater and the cathedral. Free time for lunch and personal exploring. Embark the local ferry / catamaran to Split.
Overnight at the hotel in Split area

DAY 5:

Breakfast at the hotel.

Private transfer from Split to Zadar (duration approx. 2 hrs) Upon arrival, Zadar walking sightseeing with local guide (duration approx. 2 hrs)

The Zadar peninsula still preserves very old network of

and Gradec - the commercial centre of skilful tradesmen and craftsmen. Visit the Upper Town with its Gothic Cathedral, the beautiful and ornate St. Catherine's church or the massive St. Mark's church with its famous colour-tiled roof. Continue to the medieval Stone Gate and "Dolac", the open-air market which are a must for all visitors.

Rest of the day at leisure.

Overnight at the hotel in Zagreb area.

DAY 8:

Breakfast at the hotel.

Day at leisure. OR

OPTIONAL: Excursion To Slovenia: Ljubljana & Bled (duration approx. 8 hrs)

The capital city of Slovenia lies in a basin between the Karst and the alpine region at 298 meters above sea level. It is a city with a soul, featured by the Baroque Old Town which is nestled at the foot of Castle Hill, the Art Nouveau mansions as well as some of the masterpieces of the world-renowned architect Jože Plečnik. Ljubljana nowadays presents the political, cultural, scientific and university centre of Slovenia. Adding an open-air market, Ljubljanica River that meanders through the city and a mighty castle rising above the narrow streets – all that and much more you can admire in Ljubljana.

Continue to Bled. Free time in Bled to explore on your own (up to 2 hrs)

Bled is famous for the Lake Bled, which makes it a major tourist attraction. The lake surrounds Bled Island, the only natural island in Slovenia. The island has several buildings, the main one being the Pilgrimage Church of the Assumption of Mary. Return to Zagreb.

Overnight at the hotel in Zagreb area.

DAY 9:

Breakfast at the hotel.

Private transfer from your hotel to Zagreb airport for your departure flight.
