BAALBECK, ANJAR & KSARA WINERY (WITH LUNCH)/\$95



- Heliopolis, the roman temples of Baalbeck, makes up the largest and best preserved corpus of roman architecture left around. The acropolis occupies the top of an artificial hill built up of different layers of habitation.
- Discover Anjar's city that was built in the early 8th century A.D. Inside the city's strong fortifications are the remains of streets, three palaces, souks, two hammams and a Mosque.
- Visit Ksara, the refuge of the well known Ksara wine where thousands of the old wine bottles are preserved. A tasting of the best wines is done during the visits.

JEITA, HARISSA & BYBLOS (WITH LUNCH)/\$95



- Visit Jeita, one of the world's most beautiful cavern, that was nominated for the seven world wonders.
- Byblos is one of the oldest towns in the world that goes back at least 7,000 years. The rise and fall of nearly two dozen successive levels of human culture on this site makes it one of the richest archeological areas in the country.
- Admire views of Jounieh Bay from the magnificent Our Lady of Lebanon statue at Harissa.
- No visit of any museum included in Harissa.



BEIRUT, BEITEDDIN & DEIR EL KAMAR (WITHLUNCH)/\$95



- Bus tour of Beirut's most famous landmarks, like Raouche, Zaytouna Bay and Dowtown. It is the perfect way to check the city and get to know it easily. In addition to visiting the National museum of Beirut, which is the main archeological museum in Lebanon.
- Visit the magnificent Beiteddine palace, built at the beginning of the 19th century by Emir Bechir II, who reigned over Lebanon for more than 50 years.
- Discover Deir el Kamar, a typical Lebanese village with its historical center, souk(market), museum, mosque & churches.
- No visit of any museum included in Deir El Kamar.

CEDARS, BECHARREH & KOZHAYA (WITH LUNCH)/\$95



- Check the most venerable representatives of the Cedars of Lebanon, which once covered the country's mountains.
- Dicover Becharreh, the birthplace of the famous Lebanese poet Gibran Khalil Gibran.
- Visit Kozhaya, part of the Holy valley where Maronites used to during the Ottaman's period.



TRIPOLI, SAYDET EL NOURIEH & BATROUN (WITH LUNCH)/\$95



- Tripoli is known as the capital of the North, Tripoli is Lebanon's second largest city. Due to its historical wealth, relaxed lifestyle and thriving business climate, this is a city where modern and medieval blend easily into a lively and hospitable metropolis.
- Our Lady of Nourieh (Saydet el Nourieh in Arabic) is a Marian shrine in Hamat, Lebanon.
- Visiting BatrounHere are five iconic touristic places that you should visit in Batroun: Old souk, The Phoenician wall, St Stephan cathedral, The Batroun port & Hilmi's lemonade which is one of the oldest places that was selling Lemonade back the late 19th.

SIDON, TYRE & MAGHDOUCHE (WITH LUNCH)/\$95



- Sidon is of immense antiquity, but few remains of the ancient city have survived the ravages of time and man.
- Tyre is an ancient Phoenician city and the legendary birthplace of Europa and Dido (Elissa). Today it is the fourth largest city in Lebanon[4] and houses one of the nation's major ports.
- Maghdouché's most famous landmark is the tower of Our Lady of Mantara, above the cave that is believed to have been the resting place of the Virgin Mary as she waited for Jesus while he preached in Sidon.
