

LEBANON TOUR PACKAGE **Steps of Devotion:** A Pilgrim's Journey 08 DAYS/07 NIGHTS

ITINERARY:

DAY 1: ARRIVAL IN BEIRUT – AIRPORT TRANSFER TO HOTEL

Upon arrival at **Beirut-Rafic Hariri International Airport**, you will be met by our representative for a warm **meet and greet** service. After completing airport formalities, enjoy a comfortable **private transfer to your hotel in Beirut**. Check-in and overnight stay at the hotel.

DAY 2: BEIRUT CITY TOUR & BEIT MERY & DEIR EL QALAA

After breakfast; Begin your day with a guided Tour to the National Museum of Beirut, for a deep understanding of Lebanon's History, Highlights include Phoenician Sarcophagi, Roman Mosaics, and Byzantine Icons, and much more. Continue for Beirut City walking tour, diving into the rich and layered history of the region. Your first stop is **Downtown Beirut**, where ancient meets modern. Visit the **Roman Baths** nestled near the **Grand Serail**, admire the architectural beauty of the **Parliament Building**, pause at **Martyrs' Square**, and explore the historic **St. George's Cathedral**, Al Omari Mosque. Lunch in Beirut. Afternoon: Visit the Roman Ruins of Beit Merry & Deir El Qalaa Monastery, a Maronite Monastery founded on ancient temple ruins, with striking columns, mosaic and panoramic views. Return overnight in Beirut.





DAY 3: SOUTH LEBANON: QANA, TYRE & MAGHDUSHE

After Breakfast, depart to the south of Lebanon. Begin with the UNESCO World Heritage site of Tyre, Where Roman Streets, a vast Hippodrome, and ancient harbors reveal the city's glorious past. Continue to Qana Where Jesus is said to have performed his first miracle of turning water into wine at wedding in Cana in Galilee, after Qana head to Maghdushe to see the hilltop sanctuary of Saydet el-Mantra (our lady of the awaiting), a pilgrimage site with Panoramic views where the virgin Marry waited the return of her son Jesus. On the return back, pass by Sidon or Saida, enjoy a relaxed walking tour through the old souks, pass by the soap museum and optional entrance to sea castle.



DAY 4: HARISSA LADY OF LEBANON & SAINT CHARBEL MONASTERY ANNAYA

After Breakfast, Check out from the hotel. Begin the day by taking the cable car up to Harissa to visit the hilltop sanctuary of Our lady of Lebanon with breathtaking views over the bay. The journeys continue to visit to the monastery of our lady of Deliverance (El-Cherfe) and the stricking St. Paul's Basilica nearby. continue to visit Saint Charbel Annaya Monastery. After Lunch drive back to Byblos, one of the oldest cities still inhibited till

today, enjoy a city walking tour, visit the old harbor, old Castle. Optional visit to the fossil's museum. Overnight in Byblos

DAY 5: QADISHA SACRED VALLEY

After Breakfast, check out and depart for a long Scenic drive north from Byblos to Bcharre region. Make a brief stop at the monastery of our lady of Diman, the summer residence and historic seat of the Maronite Patriarchate, overlooking the Qadisha valley. Continue to Monastery of Mar Lishaa, nestled on the valley cliffs (option of an off-road minivan transfer to reach monastery of our lady of Qannoubine), one of the oldest and most Significant convents in the valley. Enjoy lunch in the cedar's region offering panoramic view of the sacred valley.

In the afternoon, visit Bcharre village, with option to explore the khalil Gibran Museum. The concludes at the legendary Cedar Forest of Bsharre, where some of the oldest cedar trees in Lebanon still stand as a symbol of resilience & eternity.

Overnight in Bcharre.



DAY 6: BEKAA KAFRA, MONASTERY OF ST. ANTHONY QOZHAYA

After Breakfast, check out from the hotel, visit Bekaa Kafra Village, the place birth of the saint Charbel, continue to visit the monastery of St. Anthony of Qozhaya, an important monastic center in the Qadisha valley known for its cave chapel and ancient printing press, on the way back pass by the monastery of Our Lady Hamtoura, and see from outside the historic churches of Amioun, including St. John & St. Phocas. lunch in Batroun & overnight.

DAY 7: COASTAL CHARM-KFIFAN- SAYDET EL NURIYE MONASTERY

After breakfast, begin your day with a visit to the Monastery of Saints Cyprien and Justina in Kfifan, where lies the tomb of Saint Nimatullah Kassab, one of Lebanon's most beloved saints. Continue to Jrabta to visit the Monastery of Saint Joseph, home to the tomb of Saint Rafqa, revered for her faith and compassion.

Both monasteries are important pilgrimage sites that beautifully reflect the deep spiritual heritage of Mount Lebanon. Next visit Saydet El Nuriye Monastery gracefully perched on a



hill along the coast, offering serene sea views and a tranquil atmosphere perfect for reflection and photography. have lunch in Batroun, followed by a leisurely walking tour through its historic old town. End the day with a refreshing glass of Batroun's famous fresh lemonade, a local favorite and the perfect way to conclude your journey. Overnight in Beirut
