TRAILS OF THE WILD - 7 DAYS/6 NIGHTS

Day 1: ARRIVAL IN BEIRUT – AIRPORT TRANSFER TO HOTEL

Upon arrival at **Beirut-Rafic Hariri International Airport**, you will be met by our representative for a warm **meet and greet** service. After completing airport formalities, enjoy a comfortable **private transfer to your hotel in Beirut**.

Check-in and overnight stay at the hotel.

Day 2: BEIRUT CITY TOUR, RAOUCHE BOAT TRIP, BEIT EDDINE AND BAROUK RESERVE



After breakfast, start your tour in Downtown Beirut, where ancient heritage meets modern charm. Begin your tour at the Roman Baths, beautifully preserved remnants of the city's ancient past, located near the Grand Serail, Lebanon's historic government palace., then pause at Martyrs' Square, a symbolic heart of Beirut that tells the story of Lebanon's resilience and independence. Continue to visit two of the city's most iconic landmarks. Next, pass through the vibrant Beirut Souks, a blend of stylish modern boutiques and traditional market spirit. Conclude the city exploration with a leisurely drive along The Corniche, Beirut's scenic seaside promenade, where you'll enjoy a boat trip offering stunning views of the coastline and the famous Pigeon Rocks of Raouché. Then continue your journey to the **Shouf District**, one of Lebanon's most picturesque mountain regions. Visit the magnificent **Beit Eddine Palace**, a masterpiece of 19th-century Lebanese architecture built by Emir Bashir II. Wander through its **ornate**

courtyards, intricate mosaics, and beautifully decorated arcades, while learning about its rich history and cultural significance.

After a relaxing **lunch break**, continue your journey to the **Barouk Cedar Nature Reserve**, part of the famous **Shouf Biosphere Reserve** — the largest nature reserve in Lebanon.

Enjoy a peaceful walk among the majestic **Cedars of Lebanon**, some of which are thousands of years old. Breathe in the crisp mountain air, admire the panoramic views, and experience the tranquility of this pristine environment that symbolizes Lebanon's natural and cultural heritage. In the late afternoon, **return to Beirut**, filled with the serenity and beauty of Lebanon's mountains.

Day 3: JEITTA GROTTOS- HARISSA CABLE CAR – SHABROUH DAM

After breakfast, check out from the hotel and begin your journey toward the mountains of Keserwan. Start the day with a cable car ride to Harissa, where you'll visit the hilltop sanctuary of Our Lady of Lebanon. Enjoy the panoramic views over Jounieh Bay and the Mediterranean coast — one of the most iconic vistas in Lebanon. Continue to the Jeitta Grotto, a world-renowned natural wonder composed of two interconnected limestone caves featuring magnificent stalactites and stalagmites. A short boat ride through the lower grotto adds to the magic of this underground masterpiece. After Lunch head further into the mountains to visit to Shabrouh Dam, then continue to visit the statue of Saint Charbel, a revered pilgrimage site dedicated to Lebanon's most beloved saint. Return to Beirut.

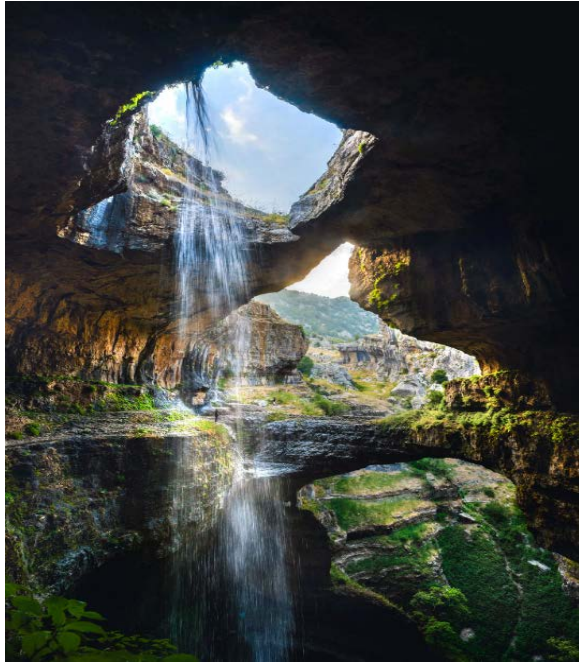


Day 4: FULL DAY HIKING & SWIMMING IN CHOUWEN LAKE

After breakfast, head north of Beirut toward the mountains of Keserwan to reach the Chouwen Nature Reserve. This hidden gem, part of the Jabal Moussa Biosphere Reserve, is known for its crystal-clear turquoise river, scenic hiking trails, and lush pine forests. Enjoy a leisurely hike down to the lake, where you can relax by the water, take photos, or even swim in the lake. Have lunch in the area. After lunch stop by Afqa waterfalls, then return back to Beirut.



DAY 5: BAATARA WATERFALLS-DOUMA VILLAGE- AKOURA PONDS



After breakfast, depart north toward the mountains of Lebanon. Your first stop is the Baatara Gorge Waterfall, a breathtaking natural wonder where water plunges 255 meters into a limestone cave, cascading through three natural bridges carved by time. This dramatic setting — a blend of rock layers, emerald valleys, and rushing water — makes it a photographer's paradise.

Continue to a local restaurant for a traditional Lebanese lunch, featuring authentic mountain flavors and homemade specialties. After lunch, drive on to Douma, a picturesque village recently recognized among the most beautiful in the world. Nestled amid lush green hills, Douma captivates

visitors with its stone houses, red-tiled roofs, and charming old souk. Stroll through its narrow alleys, discover artisanal shops and cafés, and taste local produce such as olive oil, honey, and sweets. Later, head toward Akoura Lakes, where the mountain peaks open onto a spectacular landscape of terraced hills, natural pools, and panoramic views — a perfect spot to unwind and take in the beauty of Lebanon's highlands. In the late afternoon, return to Beirut.



DAY 6: FOSSILS DIGGING ADVENTURE IN HAKEL, BYBLOS CITY TOUR

After Breakfast head to Hakei. An Adventure Embark on an unforgettable adventure to Hakei, the only place in the Middle East renowned for its remarkable fossil discoveries. This small village in Lebanon holds massive scientific significance, thanks to extraordinary geological changes that occurred millions of years ago. This natural phenomenon preserved millions of marine organisms, including fish, plants, and other sea species, turning them into fossils over time. Enjoy a full-day tour to Hakei, where adventure and discovery await. Begin with a short hike to reach the fossil site, where the site owner will share fascinating insights into the history of the fossils and provide all the essential details about the area. Next, you'll have the



opportunity to dig for fossils yourself with a bit of luck, you might uncover your very own fish fossil — becoming the first person on Earth to set eyes on a creature preserved for nearly 100 million years. Each visitor may keep one fossil they find, at the end of the tour visit the fossil Museum in Byblos. After the tour rest for Lunch. Explore Byblos, one of the **oldest continuously inhabited cities in the world**. Discover its **ancient fortress**, standing proudly on the seafront and offering panoramic views of the Mediterranean. Stroll through the **narrow alleys of the old souks**, where traditional crafts, souvenirs, and local flavors bring the city's vibrant heritage to life. Continue to the **historic old harbor**, a picturesque spot lined with colorful boats. Back to Beirut.

After breakfast, Transfer to Beirut international airport for departure.
