DAY 1: ARRIVAL – LONDON

Using your Oyster card, make your own way to Greenwich to enjoy your shared tour. Let your guide show you the most iconic sights like Cutty Sark, Royal Observatory & Meridien Line, the Old Royal Naval College and Greenwich Gardens. An action-packed tour but don't worry, you will have time to rest whilst enjoying lunch in a traditional pub. At the end of your tour take the Thames Clipper for the return journey to central London and marvel at the capital's famous sights lining both banks of this famous river.

DAY 5: WED / KESWICK - EDINBURGH
